System Safety



Basic safety precautions should be followed to protect you from harm and the Citrix Hardware Product from damage:

- Be aware of the locations of the power on/off switch, on the chassis, and the room's emergency power-off switch, disconnection switch or electrical outlet. If an electrical accident occurs, you can then quickly remove power from the system.
- Do not work alone when working with high voltage components.
- Power should always be disconnected from the system when removing or installing the appliance. Caution: The appliance may have more than one power source.
- Before disconnecting power, power down the appliance through the operating system. Then, unplug the power cords of all the power supply units in the appliance.
- When you are working around electrical circuits, another person who is familiar with the power-off controls should be nearby to switch off the power if necessary.
- Do not remove the top cover or open the appliance. Repair of the appliance isto be carried out only by a trained and authorized service technician.
- Use only one hand when working with powered-on electrical equipment. This precaution is to avoid making a complete circuit, which will cause electrical shock.
- Use extreme caution when using metal tools, which can easily damage any electrical circuits they come into contact with.
- Do not use mats designed to decrease static electrical discharge as protection from electrical shock. Instead, use rubber mats that have been specifically designed as electrical insulators
- The power supply power cords must include grounding plugs and must be plugged into grounded electrical outlets.
- Keep the area around the Citrix appliance clean and free of clutter. Caution: The appliance is not intended to be used as a shelf or workspace
- When lifting the appliance, use proper lifting techniques to avoid any potential injuries or request assistance.
